

ISSC is a set of guideline rules for a class of RC racing reflecting the look of Sportscar racing on road courses.

This includes any Sportscars that are currently raced or vintage Sportscars.

The goal is to provide a fair class of RC racing that will appeal to intermediate level racers, with a realistic visual aspect.

-SPORTSMAN SPEC RULES-

CHASSIS-

Any 4WD 1/10 Touring type chassis, 190mm-200mm, 1380 grams minimum weight.

MOTORS-

21.5 motors.

Hobbywing 21.5 locked timing Brushless motors are a good choice for equal competition at a reasonable price.

SPEED CONTROL-

ESCs with no timing adjustment are preferable. Blinky mode ESCs can be used as well. Hobbywing Just Stock ESCs with no timing adjustment are a good choice for equal competition at a reasonable price.

BATTERIES-

Any 7.4 volt 2-cell hard cassed LiPo batteries.

BODIES-

Any Sportscar style body that fits properly on a 190mm- 200mm Touring chassis. Must be representational and proportional to an existing full size car body.

ISSC encourages contemporary Sportscar bodies, but any vintage is OK. No bodies are allowed that are distorted unique designs specifically made for RC performance such as the bodies listed for the ROAR T2 class.

Have fun racing your favorite car body you have always wanted to run!!!

TIRES-

Any tires and wheels designed for 1/10th Touring cars. Spec tires such as Gravity RC G-Spec Type C Pre-mounts may be used at local events if needed for cost factors or surface conditions.
